By sharing her dreams and passions, the valedictorian hopes to inspire her classmates to set big goals and exceed their own expectations.

Age Range/Grade Level

4-8 Years/Preschool – 3rd Grade

Author Visit Overview

The main themes covered in *I Know I Can!* are themes of global exploration, self-empowerment, and social justice. Most importantly, the book encourages all kids to really believe in their potential for greatness, and to consider the work and attitude it will take to accomplish their goals.

Each author visit includes a reading of *I Know I Can!*, along with a special interactive (1.5 – 2 hour) presentation about what it means to be intelligent, courageous, adventurous, confident, and self-motivated.

Veronica N. Chapman is an entrepreneur, author, and playwright, having written and produced *Ancestors Inc.*, a motivational play for teens, and *The Advent of Planet Martyr: An Innovative Social Commentary*, a self-published book.

A graduate of Spelman College (B.A. in Spanish) and Babson College (M.B.A.), she is committed to using her gifts to act upon her ideas and improve the world. Each of her endeavors, Boxxout Enterprises, Potlucks for Progress, My Crowning Jewel, and her new children's book *I Know I Can!*, are in line with this commitment.

I Know I Can!, published under Veronica's youth organization, Boxxout (www.boxxout.org), is Veronica's first children's book. Released in November, 2015, *I Know I Can!* was inspired by Veronica's experience as a student at Spelman College, and by her desire to help fortify the self-esteem of Black girls, and inspire all young people, boys and girls alike, to dream big and have the courage to take action.

The story is centered around a courageous girl named Faith, who while giving a valedictorian speech at her high school graduation, shares her childhood dreams and the lessons that served as the foundation for her courage.

As a child Faith dreamed of touching the stars; going back in time to sing with Mahalia Jackson; and of meeting with other African-American heroes who all impart empowering words of wisdom. During the speech she also discusses her childhood dreams of things that are more attainable, such as visiting the Louvre in Paris, France, and embarking on a safari in South Africa. By sharing her dreams and passions, the valedictorian hopes to inspire her classmates to set big goals and exceed their own expectations.
